How to Apply:

1. Applicants should fill in and submit the application form <http://ic.emu.edu.tr/summerschool/index.php/forms/application-form/> and pick up service form, along with scans of your passport and your air ticket.

2. Once applicants have completed the application process, they should pay their programme fee through bank transfer according an official invoice for their programme.

How does it cost:

Fees apply to all standard language courses, including young learners courses, and to the Underwater World and Environment Courses. Fees include airport transfers and the standard activity programme. In the case of courses including international examinations, examination fees are not included. Optional activities are also not included. Fee form two weeks to four weeks: **250\$ - 900\$**.
